

- 3. Use the Reaction function in Zoom (bottom of your computer screen) and raise your hand


The moderators will be select as many individuals as possible to pose their questions live. Please keep your questions concise. Use the button below to register for this Meeting.

Bruce Allen biography

Bruce Allen is a Canadian music band manager who

represents a number of popular Canadian musicians including Bachman-Turner Overdrive, Jann Arden, Anne Murray, Bryan Adams, Prism, Loverboy and Michael Bublé. He also manages music producer Bob Rock. In 1985, Allen spearheaded the charity supergroup Northern Lights, who recorded the song "Tears Are Not Enough" in support of Ethiopian famine relief.

Bruce grew up in the Dunbar area of Vancouver, went to UBC and in 1966 formed a booking agency which booked live acts into night clubs, schools, and universities in the early 1970's. After forming an association with Sam Feldmann, he morphed into a management position and proceeded to find exciting Canadian musicians and help launch their careers to world renown. This took a lot of hard work and endless touring.

His success in the entertainment industry is only part of what he has been involved with over his lifetime. He has raised money for BC Lions Society for children with disabilities, climbed Mount Kilimanjaro fundraising for Alzheimer Society of BC. He loves sports and spent much of his energies serving on different committees helping to make the 2010 Olympic Games Opening and Closing Ceremonies a success. He has been awarded several honours, one being the Manager of the year 1985 and the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal in 2012 to acknowledge his contribution to Canadian culture.

Now in his seventies, Allen is the proud father of a recently married daughter Claire and his son Quinn. He is no longer hosting his radio program but

doesn't intend to stop working.

Current Bylaw III Management Item 4.

The Membership Chair shall, on an annual basis, develop two membership rosters for the club.

- ii) One to be sent to Club members containing only names and telephone numbers. At membership renewal time, the renewal form shall have the option for members to have their telephone number excluded from the roster.

The membership roster shall include a statement that it is not be used for commercial purposes and not shared with non-Club members.
