## Kay Meek Arts Centre - COVID-19 Meeting Protocols for our meetings

When attending PROBUS Club in-person meetings at Kay Meek Arts Centre, Members and Guests are asked to comply with the following protocols for the safety of all members and Kay Meek staff.

- All attendees must have pre-registered for the event and received a pre-assigned seat.

  Unregistered drop-ins will not be allowed in. Members must pre-book seating through Kay Meek Box Office either on-line or by phone.
- Masks are no longer required in indoor settings but encouraged in spaces where physical distancing is difficult to maintain. Therefore, Kay Meek encourages you to continue to wear your mask when attending an event in their venue.
- Reserved spaced out seating through the Kay Meek Box Office will be at 50% capacity
- As of April 8th, 2022 BC Health will no longer require BC Vaccine Passports for events.
- No refreshments are permitted in the Kay Meek theatre, however water bottles are allowed.
- If you are not feeling well or have any COVID symptoms, we ask for the safety of other members you do not attend.
